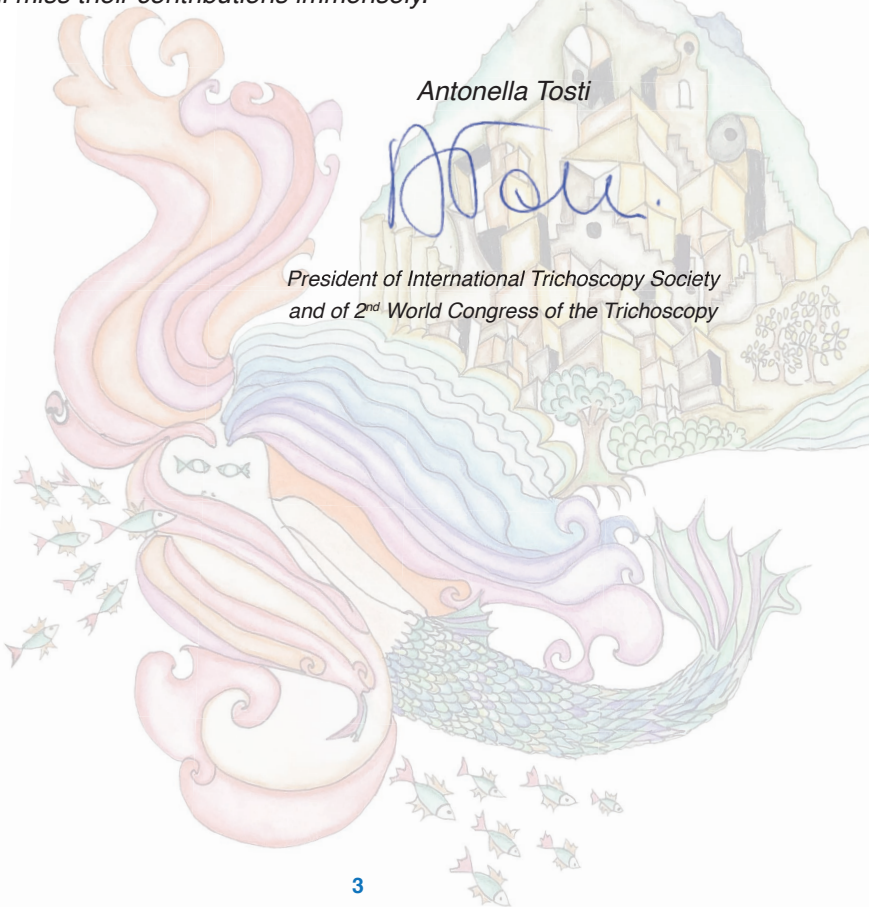
We had very interesting program with speakers from many countries, and I really hope it will be a great and informative event to remember.

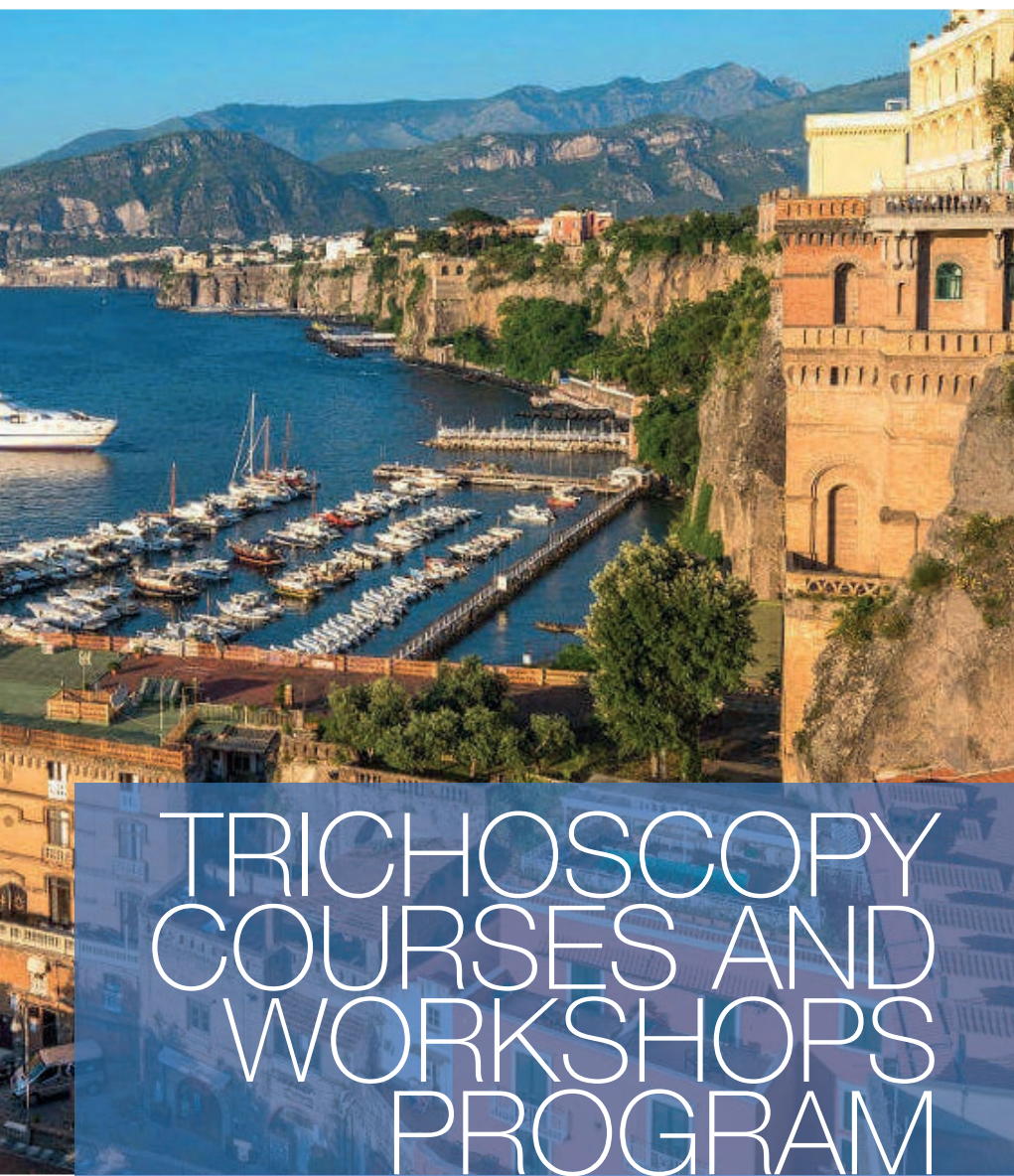

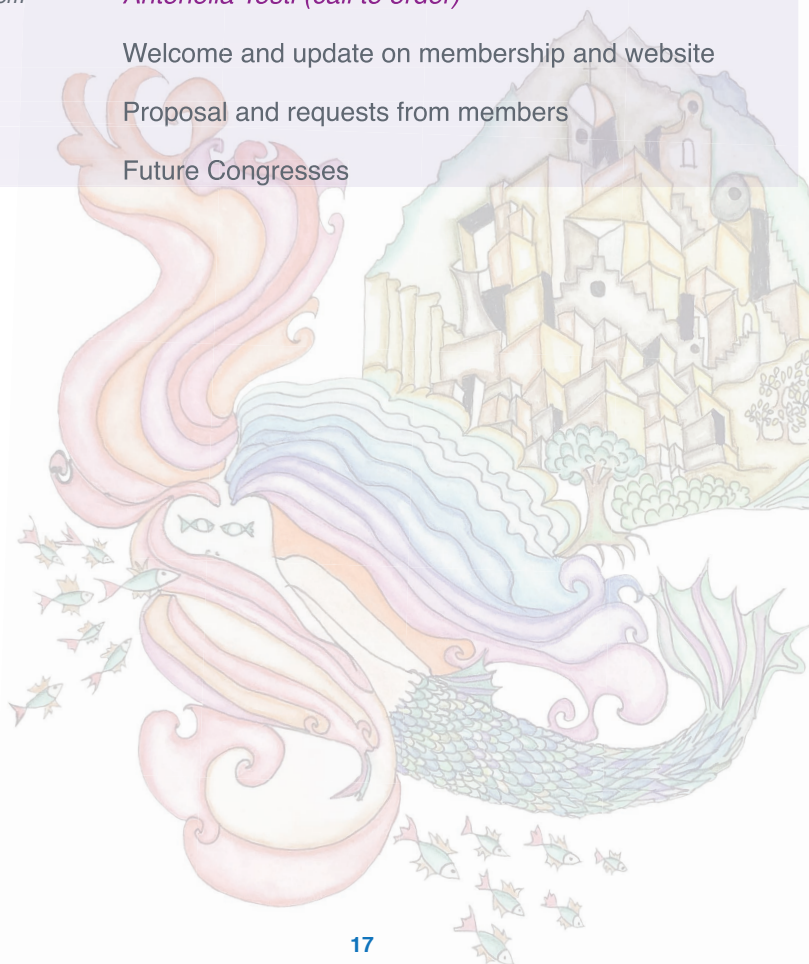

POMPEI (Half day)

Pompeii is now considered one of the world’s most important historical sites because of the way the volcanic ash preserved the city and its people. This gives historians and archaeologists a vivid picture of life in the Roman Empire around 2,000 years ago.

The first excavations were in the 18th century, and 250 years on about 75% of the town has been dug out.

PROGRAM:

09:00 Pick-up from Hilton hotel and transfer to Pompeii.

Guided visit of 2 hours showing you the main public monuments and some of the homes of the Pompeii ruins.

At the end of the visit a little bit of free time will be given before reach Sorrento by bus at approx. 01.00 pm.

Capri (Full day)

A day devoted entirely to the visit of Capri, an island rich in natural beauty, scenic, historical, and social activities that involve the whole world.

Pick up from your hotel or established meeting place, continued toward

the port of Sorrento and board the fast boat with all the comforts to make you enjoy the fascinating journey from where you can enjoy the Sorrento Peninsula to the junction of Water Gulf of Naples and the Gulf of Salerno (Punta Campanella). After about 20 minutes by boat you arrive at Marina Grande, the small port of the island that has left intact its charm despite the passage of time. After landing can be reached by minibus Anacapri, above Capri, just as the Greeks nicknamed it.

This beautiful village, which today is a town in itself, is an integral part of the island. Inhabited since Roman times, as evidenced by the many ruins, Anacapri had its heyday between the nineteenth and twentieth centuries, when it became a coveted "retreat" for artists from across Europe who came here to spend happy holidays and to find inspiration.

HOW TO GET FROM NAPLES TO SORRENTO

DRIVING FROM NAPLES TO SORRENTO

You might think that driving along a coastline as the Bay of Naples could be lovely and picturesque, and that is, in a certain way, true. Nevertheless, the roughly 50km (30mi) trip is primarily on crowded highways (so you will be probably get stuck in traffic), far away from the coast. Actually, it is unpredictable how long it will take – especially on summer weekends when it is not just the tourists who are heading for the beaches, but the locals as well.

TAKING THE BUS FROM NAPLES TO SORRENTO

If you are flying to the Airport of Naples, bypass Naples, and want to get directly to Sorrento, there is a daily coach service that starts from the airport itself (though frequency and departure times varies with the season). It is provided by Curreri. The trip lasts about a 1.25-hour.

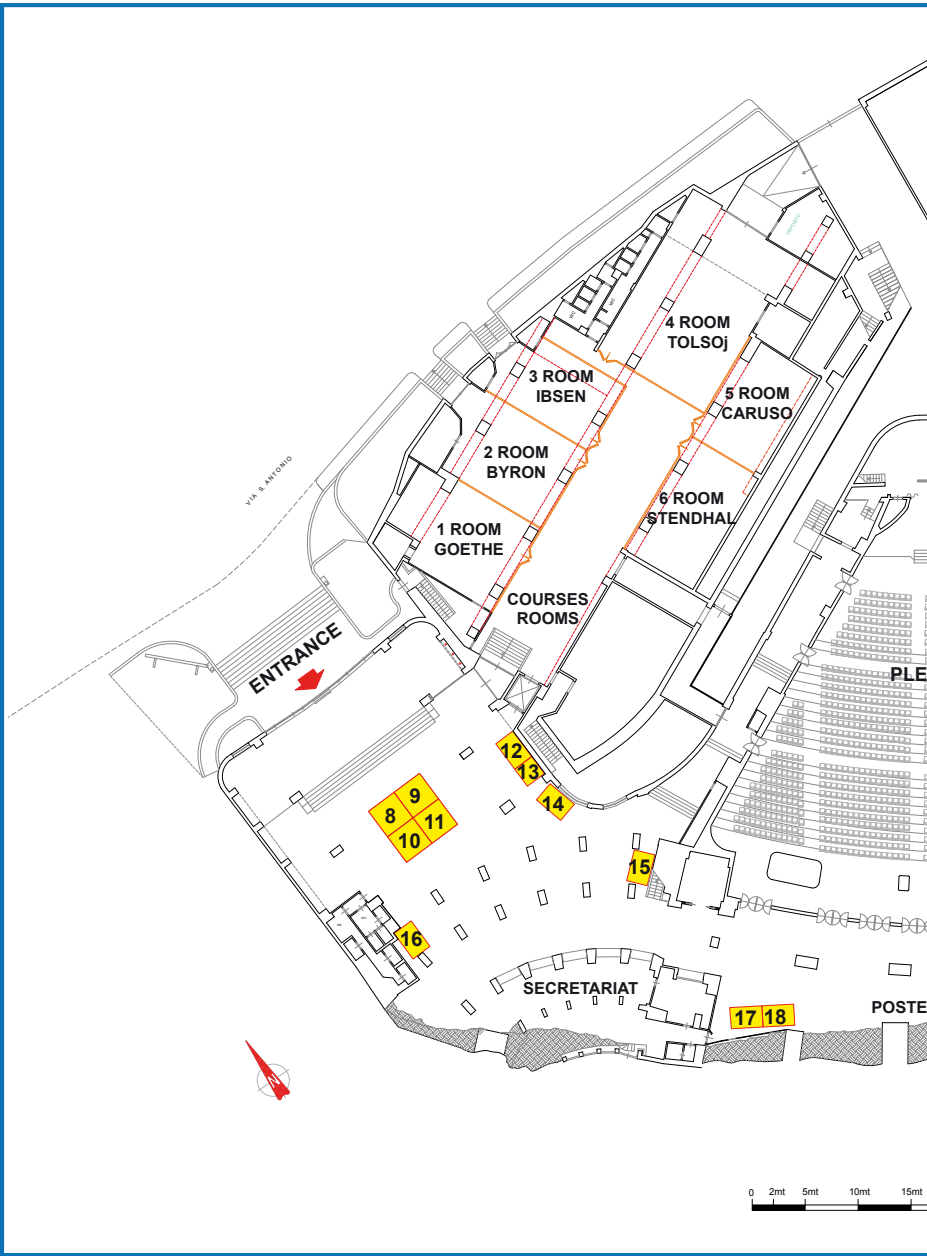
TAKING THE TRAIN FROM NAPLES TO SORRENTO

Trains from Naples to Sorrento start daily from the main station (Stazione Napoli Centrale on Piazza Garibaldi) approximately every half-hour between 06:00 and 23:00. The trip can take between one hour and one hour and twenty minutes.

TAKING A BOAT FROM NAPLES TO SORRENTO

The hydrofoil is probably your fastest option from Naples to Sorrento (taking in account that you need from 30 to 60 minutes to reach the harbor from the airport). Hydrofoils are operated by Alilauro and depart from the pier Molo Beverello in Naples near Piazza Municipio. The trip takes roughly 40 minutes one-way.

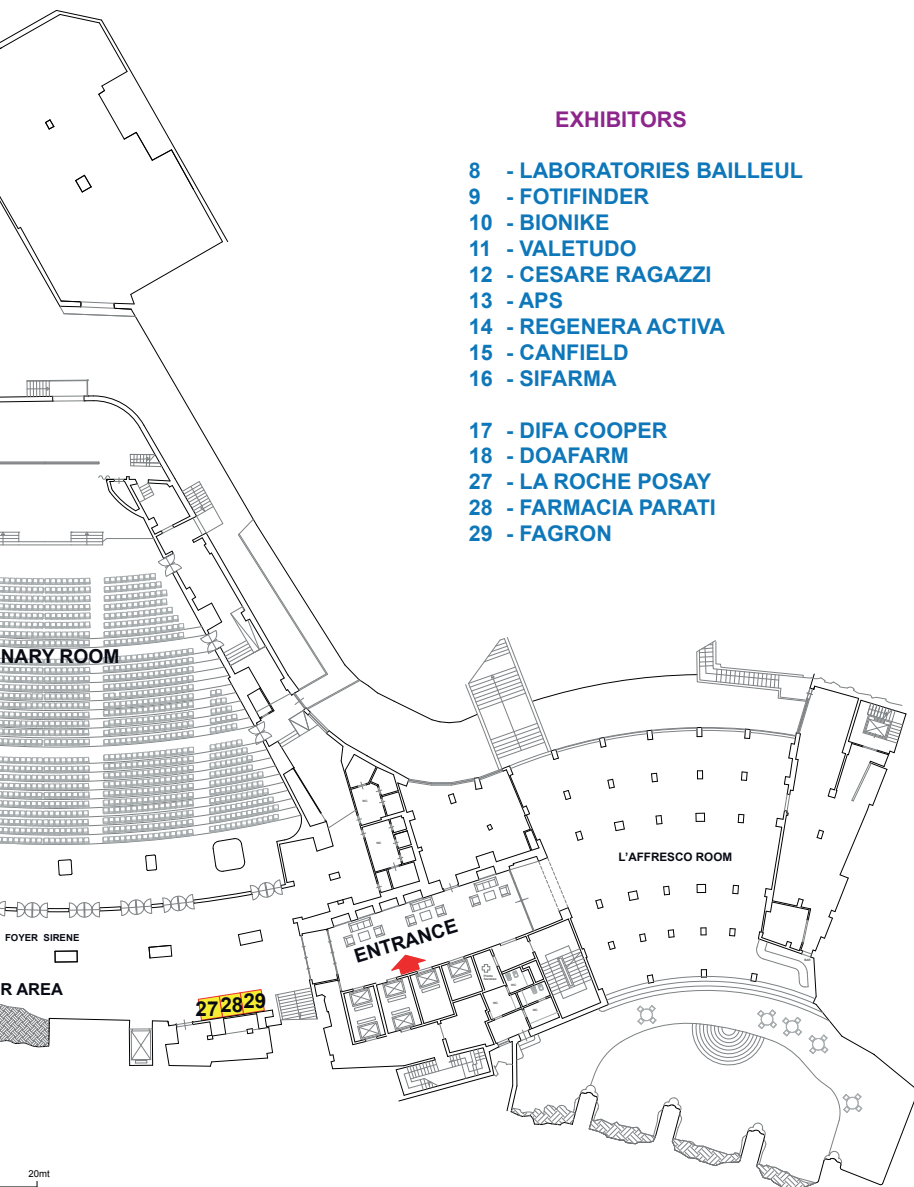
